- AHEPA members sold over \$500 million in US War Bonds during World War II.
- Today, AHEPA members annually provide tens of thousands of community service hours globally.
- Throughout its history, AHEPA's leadership has been welcomed in The White House and on Wall Street, and invited to meet with global leaders and heads of state of Europe.
- Over \$1,000,000,000 in humanitarian aid has been extended by AHEPA members to people all over the world, including victims of natural disasters such as Hurricanes Katrina, Harvey, Sandy and Michael as well as the recent fires in Greece.
- Collectively, over \$1,800,000 in AHEPA scholarships are awarded annually to Greek-American youth. Ongoing support of multiple study abroad programs includes AHEPA's annual Journey to Greece.
- The Order has established two hospitals in Greece which remain active in service to local citizens as well as visiting AHEPANs.
- AHEPA representatives maintain an active presence on Capitol Hill and a focus on international affairs that impact the safety and well-being of Greek-Americans and Orthodox Christians worldwide.
